



CODE OF CONDUCT

The Loft is a place for meetings and activities. To make it pleasant for everyone who goes there, please read the following code of contact and put it into practice:

- 1. I respect the activity leaders, other young people and their differences, in other words, I will not engage in racism, harassment, intimidation or discrimination;
- 2. I use respectful language and a respectful tone of voice; swear words and any other profanity are not tolerated;
- 3. I accept that the activity leaders may deny me access to the Loft if they suspect me of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol;
- 4. I am responsible for anything I break or damage either intentionally or accidentally. The "if you break it, you buy it policy" is applied as follows:
 - I will pick up, clean up or repair any mess or damage I cause at my own expense;
 - In case of major damage, my parents will be informed;
 - Military parents remain ultimately liable for any expenses;
- 5. I respect the Loft's premises and equipment by not engaging in vandalism;
- 6. I take care of the Loft's equipment by adopting the following behaviours and attitudes:
 - By taking my shoes off at the entrance;
 - By keeping the volume of my music at a reasonable level;
 - By helping to keep the premises clean, especially by throwing my garbage in the designated places, washing my own dishes and cleaning the room and the equipment after I use them.
- 7. I respect the activity leader's right to supervise the music that is listened to and the films that are watched;
- 8. I understand that no sexual contact is permitted at the Loft;
- 9. I understand that physical or verbal violence is not tolerated.

The activity leader can ask me to leave the premises at any time if I do not comply with the abovementioned points.
