



Information for parents

Summer 2024 at the Centre d'intégration communautaire jeunesse (CICJ)

To all parents,

The Montreal-area Military Family Resource Centre offers a bilingual animation service at 40 rue La Vérendrye in Saint-Hubert. The animators have planned a variety of activities for the youngsters for all the weeks of the summer opening.

In order to ensure that the days run smoothly, this document sets out the main information you need to know to ensure that CICJ activities run smoothly.

Clientele

Only children aged 5 (attending school) to 12 from military or veteran families are eligible for the Youth Community Integration Center.

Cost

Activities are free of charge.

Schedule

- From June 25, 2024 to August 15, 2024, Tuesday to Thursday.
- The CICJ is open from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Lunchtime is not included.

Registration











- Registration is mandatory on the MFRC portal: crfmmfrcmtl.ca
- Priority is given to children aged 5 to 12 registered on the portal (registration is mandatory.
- The registration form must be completed and brought in before the start of the first attendance at the CICJ. All information must be completed.
- Any allergies or important medical conditions must be indicated on the registration form so that we can plan the right supervision methods and pay particular attention to the children's health and safety.

Leaving home

- It is important to indicate on the registration form whether the child can leave alone or must wait for the parent to return home.
- It is also necessary to indicate on the registration form whether the child can return
 home at any time during the period, or whether he or she must wait until the end of the
 activity period.

Children's personal items

No personal items from home may be brought to the MFRC, other than those required for basic needs, such as :

- Backpack
- Hat/cap
- Bottled water
- Snack (no peanuts or nuts)
- Bottled water
- Sunscreen
- Bathing suit and towel
- Plastic bag (to put wet items back in the bag)
- Jacket or coat











- Helmet (if cycling)
- Epipen (if allergic)

Don't forget to identify your child's equipment.

The MFRC is not responsible for the loss or breakage of personal items brought to the CICJ.

Closure in case of unforeseen circumstances

We may be unable to offer services due to excessive heat, power failure or any other cause beyond our control. In case of doubt, parents can call the MFRC to check if it is open. We will contact parents to let them know. A sign will also be put on the door, as well as an announcement on our social media. If the event occurs during the day, we will contact parents to arrange for them to pick up their children.
