

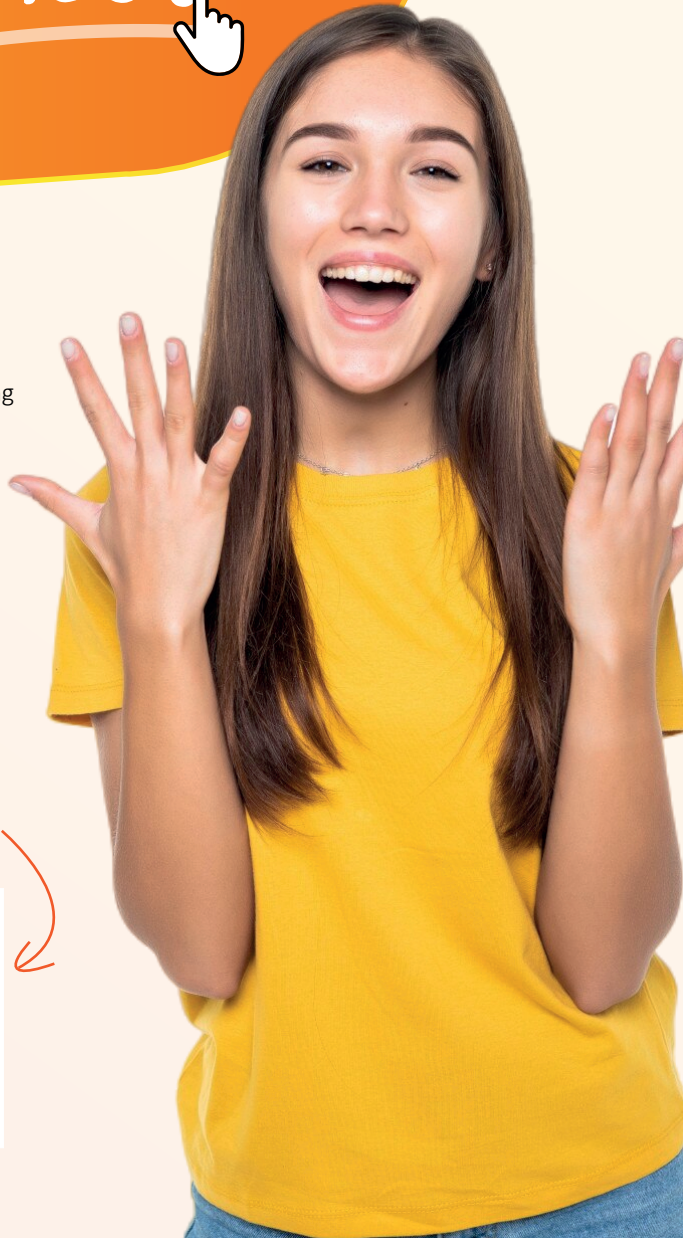


Parents' Guide to

Youth connect

The Youth Connect platform offers a variety of virtual services for children of serving Canadian Armed Forces members and veterans. This tool is designed for young people aged 9 to 17, and it is currently available at more than 22 MFRCs across Canada.

The mission of the Youth Connect application is to serve as a safe gathering place for young people who are going through similar experiences. The resources and activities accessible on the platform have a positive impact on mental health and the feeling of belonging, which are essential formative elements for adolescents.

By using the application, young people gain access to the following resources:

- ▶ Evening discussions with professionals (social worker, special education teacher, etc.)
- ▶ Youth ambassador committee
- ▶ Youth volunteering
- ▶ Fun activities
- ▶ Themed workshops

When registering, the young person must sign to indicate their acceptance of the code of conduct, in order to contribute to creating a respectful, positive and encouraging environment.

Only the administrators of the respective MFRCs can create a participant's account. That way, access is limited to registered participants only. The application is also subject to provincial and federal privacy and confidentiality policies.

After registering, the young person must create an avatar. Since the avatar is a character that represents the participant, the participant can modify it while remaining true to their identity and their cultural community.
