

## Life Code for the virtual Loft

- I use respectful language and tone of voice: vulgar language, swearing and insults will not be tolerated.
- I respect others and their differences: open-mindedness towards others and acceptance of their differences.
- No form of discrimination will be accepted: intimidation, harassment, racism, etc.
- It is forbidden to show up at the virtual youth centre in a state of alcohol or drug use.
- I agree to listen to the facilitators' instructions.
- I agree to participate in the proposed activities.
- I agree not to photograph or film the conversations and any other content in the context of the virtual youth centre.
- I wear appropriate and decent clothing that does not promote violence, nudity, illegal substances or vulgarity.
- I wait my turn to speak: I can raise my hand, write in the chat or wave to let others know that I want to talk.
- I open my camera when I participate in a live activity on Zoom.
- I turn off my microphone when it's someone else's turn to speak.
- In the chat, I use a respectful and appropriate vocabulary.
- In the arcades and games section, I must leave my place after my turn when there is another person who wants to play.
