



SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES FACING ILLNESS, INJURY OR BEREAVEMENT

The **Family Liaison Officer** (FLO) is a specialized social worker whose role is to provide support to families of military members who are ill, injured, undergoing medical release, or grieving the loss of a loved one.

The FLO helps families identify their needs through one-time consultations or ongoing psychosocial support. Meetings can take place in person, via videoconference or over the phone, and are available to children, teens, and adults, whether individually, as a couple, or as a family.

Support may address a variety of issues, including:

- Bereavement
- · Adjustment to illness or injury
- Emotional or caregiver burnout
- Any other psychosocial challenge related to a loved one's illness or the loss of a Canadian Armed Forces member

In addition, we provide a variety of resources to support you, including informational materials such as brochures, practical guides, and reliable websites, all carefully selected to meet your needs. We can also refer you to partner organizations that offer complementary services to ensure you receive comprehensive support. Finally, we offer practical advice tailored to your reality, to help you make informed decisions and move forward at your own pace.

Information, Support and Intervention Groups

Group sessions are also available for loved ones of military members living with an **Operational Stress Injury** (OSI). These groups provide a space to share, learn, and build coping strategies.
